Introduction

This bibliography lists all the publicly available papers of which we are aware, that have made original use of the data from the WERS series. This series includes the Workplace Employment Relations Surveys of 1998, 2004 and 2011, as well as the Workplace Industrial Relations Surveys of 1980, 1984 and 1990.

The bibliography is a valuable resource for two reasons. First, it helps to avoid any duplication among researchers. Second, it demonstrates the value of the survey to funders.

Structure

The following types of publication are separately listed:

- ‘Sourcebooks’ reporting the primary analysis carried out by the research team for the sponsoring bodies
- Other books wholly based on data from the WERS series
- Book chapters
- Journal articles
- Working papers
- Mimeos
- Reports
- Doctoral theses
- Dissertations

Note that where the first author’s name is preceded by an asterisk (*) this indicates that the publication is a technical report or methodological paper.

Within each section, publications are ordered in reverse chronological order (i.e. those published most recently appear first).
